

## Euro Printing solutions

### New Euro-Enabled Printers

HP offers a variety of solutions to enable you to print the Euro currency symbol on any model of HP printer and in any IT environment. All of the HP LaserJet printers introduced in Fall 1998 already support the Euro character.

The HP LaserJet 3100, 8100 and HP Color LaserJet 4500, 8500, and Mopier 320 are currently enabled to print the Euro character under Windows 95/98 and NT 4.0.

All HP InkJet printers can print the Euro-symbol from Euro-enabled Microsoft Windows applications. (Watch [www.hp.com](http://www.hp.com) for updates on HP InkJet printers enabled to print in non-Windows environments.)

#### LaserJet and HP InkJet Printers

1. Are you looking for a very simple solution that works across a broad range of products and operating systems? Do you have older operating systems such as Window 3.x or NT 3.51, or are you printing in a non-Windows environment?

HP offers free Euro Sign and Euro Sign Mono symbol fonts that can be used with any operating system and with all current and older HP LaserJet and HP InkJet printer models. You can download these now from the web.

2. Do you want a more robust software solution to use under Windows 95/98 or NT 4.0? If you have Windows 95/98 or NT 4.0 and want to have a more robust software solution for documents that will be shared by many people electronically, HP provides a matching euro character for all the HP system fonts. These are supported by all HP InkJet printers and all HP LaserJet printers back to the HP LaserJet 4 family. You can download them now from the web. These font updates are also available on CD through HP's software distribution channel.
